If I Should Die Before I Wake...

(James 4:13-17)

Introduction: 1. Life is full of questions and life contains so many mysteries about which we will never know all the answers.

- 2. Today I wish to bring to your attention two of the most important questions you could ever ask.
 - a. If you die before tomorrow morning, how are you going to spend eternity?
 - b. If you wake up tomorrow morning, how are you going to spend the rest of your life?

I. If You Die Before Tomorrow Morning, How Are You Going To Spend Eternity?

- A. The only way to the Father is through Jesus (John 14:6).
- B. If one's name is not written in the Lamb's book of life, they cannot enter Heaven (Revelation 20:11-15; 21:27).
- C. However, if one is a Christian, Heaven is within his grasp.
 - 1. (Romans 8:31-39) If you don't make it, it's not because God gave up on you, but because you gave up on God.
 - 2. (Hebrews 2:10).
 - 3. (1 John 1:7; 2:1).

II. If You Wake Up Tomorrow Morning, How Are You Going To Spend The Rest Of Your Life?

- A. Do Good.
 - 1. (Acts 10:38).
 - 2. (Titus 2:7,14; 3:8,14).
 - 3. (Mark 9:41).
- B. Do Good, Regardless.
 - 1. (Romans 12:2).
 - 2. (Hebrews 12:4).

Conclusion: 1. So, how would you answer these two questions?

- 2. I can't think of any two questions that get to the heart of the meaning of our lives any more than these two questions do.
- 3. Obviously, you awoke today having been given another day to live. How do you plan to spend it?
