How Do I Know I Am Saved?

(1 John 5:11-13)

- Introduction: 1. Must we live in doubt and fear, or does God give us assurances of our salvation?
 - 2. And if there is a way to gain assurance, then how to we come to possess it?
 - 3. This lesson is designed to give you peace of mind in the assurance that you are a child of God, and if you don't have that assurance, to motivate you to do what you need to go to have assurance.

I. Can We Be Sure About Our Salvation?

- A. Yes!
- B. (2 Peter 1:10) Make your calling and election sure...
- C. (2 Timothy 4:6-8) There is laid up for me a crown of righteousness...
- D. (2 Timothy 1:12) I know whom I have believed...
- E. (1 John 2:3-5) Hereby we know that we know him...
- F. (1 John 5:13) That you might know you have eternal life...

II. How Do We Possess Assurance?

- A. Get In Christ!
 - 1. (1 John 5:11-12) Eternal life is in his Son.
 - 2. (Ephesians 2) Predestined in Him.
 - 3. (Romans 6:3; Galatians 3:27) Baptized into Jesus.
 - 4. Remember that there is a difference in being near or with Jesus; one must be "in Him."
- B. The Spirit Bears Witness with our Spirit
 - 1. (Romans 8:16).
 - 2. Note the prepositions "with," not "to."
- B. Once in, we must stay in.
 - 1. (John 15:1-5) Abide in him.
 - 2. (2 Corinthians 13:5) Examine yourselves...
 - a. Our problem is that when we examine ourselves we often feel insecure because we grade ourselves by the wrong standard.
 - b. It's not "perfection" but "direction" that determines our status.
 - c. None of us will escape sin completely, but is sin the exception or the rule.
 - 1) Does sin have dominion over you (Romans 14:6)?
 - 2) When you sin, do you confess or defend yourself (1 John 1:7-9).
 - 3) (1 Kings 15:5).

Conclusion: 1. Friends, we can be sure. The question is, are you sure of your salvation?
