Introduction: 1. Question: Can Jesus be seen is us?

- 2. Hopefully, the world can see Him in our lives.
 - a. (2 Cor. 3:2) "An epistle written and read among all men..."
 - b. (Acts 4:13) "They realized that they had been with Jesus."
- 3. In 1 Kings 17:24, the widow of Zarephath made a very thought provoking statement: "Now by this, I know that you are a man of God..."
- 4. It is this statement that we want to consider. By what do we make known to the world that we are children of God?

I. By Our Love

- A. (John 13:34-35) Love identifies the disciples of Christ.
- B. (1 Thess. 4:9) Love was a fundamental characteristic of the early church.
- C. (Galatians 5:2) Love is one of the fruits of the Spirit.
- D. (1 Corinthians 13:1-8) Characteristics of genuine love.

II. By Our Light

- A. (Matthew 5:16) Let your light so shine...
- B. (Ephesians 5:8-15) Light exposes error and illuminates righteousness.
- C. (John 19:38) Joseph of Arimathea was a secret disciple.
 - 1. As a secret disciple, Joseph of Arimathea lived in obscurity.
 - 2. But because he took courage to cast his influence in the right direction, he will be remembered forever.

III. By Our Loyalty

- A. Our loyalty can be summarized in three categories:
 - 1. Loyalty to God [bearing the marks of Christ in your body] (Galatians 6:17).
 - 2. Loyalty to Others [bearing one another's burdens] (Galatians 6:2).
 - 3. Loyalty to Self [bearing your own burdens] (Galatians 6:5).

IV. By Our Longing

- A. (Matthew 6:19-21) Your heart is where your treasure is.
- B. (Hebrews 11:8-10) Abraham longed for a Heavenly home.
- C. (Philippians 1:21-23) Paul desired to be with Christ.

Conclusion:

- 1. Let us resolve to manifest the Lordship of Christ in our lives.
- 2. Cloth yourself with the mind and spirit of Christ and allow Him to live in and through you.
- 3. Christ in us is our only hope of glory (Colossians 1:27).
