- C. Are they evangelistic?
 - 1. (Matthew 28:19-20).

III. Questions That Are Seldom Asked When Church Shopping

- A. What can I do to help this church?
 - 1. (Romans 12:4-8).
- B. Will the leaders discipline me and hold me accountable?
 - 1. (Hebrews 13:17).
- C. Will this church require me to sacrifice?
 - 1. (2 Samuel 24:24).
