You Have To Believe It To See It

(Luke 17:11-19)

Introduction: 1. Some people denigrate Christianity because it is a religion of "faith" and not "sight."

- 2. However, upon minimal reflection, we soon realize there are many established and unquestionable truths that are not seen.
- 3. In fact, "seeing isn't always believing," for our eyes can trick us.
- 4. In this lesson, I want to call your attention to three things you have to "believe to see."

I. You Have To Believe In Order To See Prayer Work

- A. (James 1:5-8).
- B. If we do not believe, our prayers will not be answered.
- C. (James 5:16).

II. You Have To Believe In Order To Be Healed By The Lord

- A. (Luke 17:11-19).
 - 1. Jesus told the ten lepers to go show themselves to the priests.
 - 2. But notice They weren't healed, then told to go. They were healed as they were going.
 - 3. They believed before they received the blessing.
- B. (Acts 8:37).
 - 1. In this context, we are addressing a "spiritual healing."
 - 2. "If you believe, you may..." (Acts 8:37).

III. You Have To Believe In Order To See Heaven

- A. (2 Corinthians 5:1-10).
 - 1. We walk by faith and not by sight (2 Corinthians 5:7).
- B. (Hebrews 11:6).
- B. (John 8:24).

Conclusion:

- 1. Christianity is indeed a religion of faith.
- 2. Most of what we believe, we haven't seen.
- 3. But that doesn't make it less reliable.
- 4. God has left us sufficient evidence to allow us to confidently place our faith in Him, having full assurance that we will someday see what we now only believe.
