Jesus Marveled!

(Mark 6:1-6)

Introduction: 1. There are things in life that happen which cause us to marvel or stand in amazement.

- 2. Not only did this happen to the people who heard Jesus preach and saw his power, but it also happened to Jesus.
- 3. Let's examine a few verses from an event in the life of Jesus and learn a few lessons from this account.

I. The People Were Amazed By Jesus

- A. (Mark 6:1-3).
- B. They were amazed by his teaching (Mark 6:2).
 - 1. If we want to catch people's attention today, we need to know the word and preach it as did Jesus.
 - 2. (Titus 2:15; 1 Timothy 4:12).
- C. They Were amazed by his mighty works (Mark 6:2).
 - 1. They saw his miracles and couldn't bring themselves to see who he was.
 - 2. Faith wasn't necessary for the miracle, but why continue to do the miracles if no one has an open mind (Mark 6:5).

II. Jesus Was Amazed By The People

- A. (Mark 6:6).
- B. Twice in Scripture, the Bible tells us that Jesus "marveled."
 - 1. (Mark 6:6) because of unbelief.
 - 2. (Matthew 8:10) because of belief.
- C. When Jesus looks at our lives, what would cause him to marvel, our belief or our unbelief?
- D. Let this be a warning to us.
 - 1. We can harden ourselves to the point that we become unable to be touched by Jesus.
 - 2. (Ephesians 4:19; 1 Timothy 4:2; Hebrews 3:12-13).
- E. Rejection Didn't stop Jesus (Mark 6:1,4,6).
 - 1. Even Jesus' own family were unbelievers (John 7:5; Mark 3:21,31).
 - 2. Serve God for nothing (Job 1:9).

Conclusion:

- 1. May we learn from the determination of Jesus, and may we also learn a lesson from the hard heartedness of his home town.
