- Introduction: 1. Some time ago, I asked several people the question, "What would you ask God if you had the chance."
 - 2. I compiled several hundred answers to that question and plan to do a series of lessons on it eventually.
 - 3. But today, I wanted to pick out a few of the "most asked questions" from the list.
 - 4. As we go through this lesson, I want you to take notice of this fact: Many of the questions we would ask God, have already been answered by God.
 - 5. Those answers are right at our fingertips, in the Bible.

I. God, Where Did You Come From?

- A. (Psalm 90:2).
- B. (Psalm 93:2).
- C. The concept of "eternity" and an "eternal cause" is not just a "religious" view.

II. God, Why Did You Create Man?

- A. (Acts 17:24-25).
- B. (1 John 4:8).
- C. Why do humans have children?

III. God, How Do You Love The Sinner While Hating The Sin?

- A. (1 Timothy 1:13).
- B. Because they just don't fully comprehend.

IV. God, Is Jesus Coming Back In My Lifetime?

- A. (Matthew 24:36).
- B. Sometimes God's answers are simply, "Trust me."

V. God, Am I Saved?

- A. (Romans 8:16).
- B. The Holy Spirit and our spirit bear witness to the fact of whether we are saved or are not saved.

- 1. As we have examined some of these popular questions that we would ask God, I hope you took notice of this fact: The answers to the above questions were all contained in the Scriptures.
- 2. In other words, we already had the answers to these questions.
