The Prototype of False Religion

(1 Kings 12:1-33)

- Introduction: 1. This lesson is intended to serve as a warning to the people of God.
 - 2. 1 Kings 12 demonstrates how, even God's people, can be carried away from God through an accommodating, pleasant religion.
 - 3. Consider the similarities between the religion of Jeroboam and so many religions today.

I. Jeroboam Changed The Object Of Worship

- A. (Exodus 20:3-5; Deuteronomy 6:13).
- B. Jeroboam made two golden calves (vs. 28).
- C. (Matthew 4:10).

II. Jeroboam Changed The Place Of Worship

- A. (Deuteronomy 12:10-11) Jerusalem.
- B. Jeroboam set up his golden calves in Dan and Bethel (v. 29).
- C. Convenience.

III. Jeroboam Changed The Priesthood

- A. (Numbers 3:5-13).
- B. Jeroboam made priest from among every class of people (v. 31).
- C. Broadminded.

IV. Jeroboam Changed The Feast Day

- A. (Leviticus 23:33-34) 7th month, 15th day.
- B. Jeroboam celebrated his feast day on the 8th month, 15th day (v. 32).

V. Jeroboam Changed True Religion to a Similar Religion

- A. Everything had to be done according to the pattern (Hebrews 8:5).
- B. Jeroboam's religion had its origin in the human heart (vs. 26, 32).
- C. In reality there are only two types of religion:
 - 1. "I say" -vs- "God says."
 - 2. "I think" -vs- "It is written."
- D. (Jeremiah 10:23; Isaiah 55:9; Proverbs 16:25).
- E. (Matthew 15:13).

VI. Jeroboam Changed The Honor Due God To Dishonor

- A. (Malachi 1:6).
- B. Jeroboam's religion was instituted for his own selfish ends (vs. 27-29).

VII. Jeroboam Changed The Demands of God

- A. (Matthew 7:13-14).
- B. Jeroboam's religion was accommodating and convenient for the people (v. 28).

Conclusion: 1. So you see, false religion is not new.

- 2. Satan doesn't mind one being religious, so long as he does not obey and follow the Lord.
- 3. Don't get caught up in a religious system that doesn't honor God and his word.
