- J. Stretch Yourself (1 Timothy 4:15).

- B. Esteem them (1 Thessalonians 5:12-13).
- C. Obey them (Hebrews 13:17).
- D. Shield them (1 Timothy 5:19).
- E. Imitate them (Hebrews 13:7).
