II. There Was Once Refuge in the House of the Israelites

III. There Once Was Refuge in Rahab's House

- A. (Joshua 2:12-14).
- B. (Joshua 6:22, 25).
- C. Outside of Rahab's house was utter destruction (Joshua 6:21).

IV. There Once Was Refuge in a City

- A. (Numbers 35:9-34).
- B. (Numbers 35:26-27).
- C. Outside of these six cities of Refuge, there was no refuge.

V. Today, We Have Refuge in Jesus

- A. All spiritual blessings are in him (Ephesians 1:3).
- B. We are a new creation in Jesus (2 Corinthians 5:17).
- C. We are reconciled to God in Jesus (Ephesians 2:16).
- D. We are blessed in death by being in Jesus (Revelation 14:13).
