## Who Are the Churches of Christ?

(Matthew 16:18)

# Introduction: 1. It is just as difficult today to explain our way of life to a 1<sup>st</sup> century person than it is for a 1<sup>st</sup> century person to explain his way of life to us.

- 2. All we know of 21<sup>st</sup> century Christianity is denominational.
- 3. Consequently, many today think that churches of Christ are just another denomination or "flavor" of Christianity.
- 4. But is that so? Let's talk about that.

### I. The Church of Christ is Not a Denomination

- A. Detractors will say the church of Christ sprang from the restoration movement in the early 1800's.
- B. Furthermore, I listened to a podcast wherein two preachers said that the churches of Christ originated in the 1810s, 1820s, led by Barton W. Stone, Alexander and Thomas Campbell.
- C. Sometimes, you will hear people call us "Campbellites," suggesting we are followers of Alexander Campbell.
  - 1. Campbell denied being the founder of a church.
  - 2. (Acts 24:14).
  - 3. The seed principle (Luke 8:11-15).
  - 4. Campbell, Stone, and others, merely awakened the minds of people to shed the baggage of sectarianism and go back to the church of the Bible (2 Kings 22).

#### II. The Church of Christ Opposes Denominationalism

- A. Jesus prayed for his followers to be united (John 17:20-23).
- B. Imagine the apostles all forming various sects (1 Corinthians 1:10-13).
- C. Denominationalism stands contrary to the prayer and will of Jesus.
- D. Consequently, we call me out of denominations to be Christians only.

#### III. What Then, Are Churches of Christ?

- A. We are simply Christians, who have been convicted by the same message Peter preached on the Day of Pentecost (Acts 2:36), and who have responded to his message in the same way they did 2000 years ago (Acts 2:37-38).
- B. As a result, the Lord has added us to his church (Acts 2:47).
- C. And, as his church, we call men out of the world, and out of various sects, to believe in Jesus and allow him to be their Savior and Lord.

#### Conclusion: 1. With this, I know Jesus would be well-pleased.

- 2. If we will resolve to believe what Jesus taught the 1<sup>st</sup> century church to believe, do what we taught them to do, then we will be what they were the church of Jesus Christ!
