Three Things

About Angels

(Hebrews 1:14)

Introduction: 1. Tonight will continue a series of twelve lessons that will be presented this year under the title of "Three Things."

- 2. Each month, we will address three things regarding various Bible topics.
- 3. Tonight's topic is "Three Things About Angels."

I. Angels Were Created and Have Free-Will

- A. (Psalm 148:2,5).
- B. (Colossians 1:15-17).
- C. Some angels fell.
 - 1. (2 Peter 2:4).
 - 2. (Jude 6).
- D. There is no mention that Jesus' sacrifice was for the angels (1 John 2:1-2).
- E. What caused their fall?
 - 1. (Jude 6).
 - 2. (Ezekiel 28:12-19)

II. Angels Take Many Forms

- A. I sometimes find it humorous to think about how we describe angels.
- B. Angels have taken the form of:
 - 1. Men (Genesis 18:2).
 - 2. Fiery horses and chariots (2 Kings 6:17).
 - 3. Invisible (Numbers 22; 2 Kings 6).
 - 4. Wind and fire (Hebrews 1:7).
- C. There are also classes of angels.
 - 1. Cherubim (Genesis 3:24).
 - 2. Seraphim (Isaiah 6:1-3).
 - 3. Archangel (1 Thessalonians 4:6).

III. Angels Are Agents of God.

- A. In other words, sometimes God does things through the agency of angels.
- B. They execute judgment (2 Samuel 24:15-17; Matthew 13:41-42).
- C. They minister to saints (Hebrews 1:14; Psalm 34:7; Matthew 18:10).
- D. They escort the deceased saints to Paradise (Luke 16:22).
- E. They engage in spiritual warfare (Daniel 10:13-21).

Conclusion:

- 1. I find it interesting that the Father (John 3:16), Son (Ephesians 1:7), Holy Spirit (2 Peter 1:21), and angels (1 Peter 1:12) may have a greater interest in our salvation than we do.
- 2. Don't thwart the work of God and his agents, the angels, by refusing to respond to God's grace in faith.
