Three Things

About The Second Coming of Jesus

(2 Peter 3:1-13)

Introduction: 1. When's the last time you thought about the second coming of Jesus?

- 2. There is so much confusion about the return of Jesus.
- 3. Tonight, will be the third lesson of a series of twelve lessons that will be presented this year under the title of "Three Things."
- 4. Tonight's topic is "Three Things About the Second Coming of Jesus."

I. There Will Be No Signs

- A. There have been countless people predicting the time of Jesus' return.
- B. However, consider what the Bible says:
 - 1. As a thief in the night (2 Peter 3:10).
 - 2. Don't know the day or hour (Matthew 24:36; 25:13).
 - 3. It will be as in the days of Noah (Matthew 24:37-40).
 - 4. He is coming when he is not expected (Matthew 24:44).
- C. But what about the signs in (Matthew 24:1-28)?

II. There Will Be No Rapture

- A. One of the reasons members of the body of Christ know little about the rapture is because the Bible doesn't mention it.
- B. The theory of the rapture is that there are two "comings of Jesus."
 - 1. One is for the saints (1 Thessalonians 4:14-18).
 - 2. The second is with the saints (1 Thessalonians 3:13).
- C. But these aren't two comings, but two facts about his one coming.
 - 1. He is coming for the saints still on earth (1 Thessalonians 4:17).
 - 2. And when he comes for the saints still on the earth, he will bring the saints who had already departed to be with him (Ecclesiastes 12:7).
 - 3. Consider (John 5:28-29).

III. It Will Be a Day of Victory

- A. So many Christians needlessly live in fear of Jesus' return.
- B. While it will be a day of destruction and vengeance on the disobedient, that is not how it is described for the child of God (2 Thessalonians 1:8).
- C. However, consider these verses:
 - 1. (2 Thessalonians 1:7) Rest.
 - 2. (Hebrews 9:28) Salvation.
 - 3. (John 14:1-3) Coming to receive us.
- Conclusion: 1. Live expectantly, looking for the coming of Jesus.
 - 2. And if you do, you need not fear his coming, but rather will triumphantly rejoice at his appearing!
 - 3. If you're not prepared, get right while you still can!
